The **Museum Galleries** tell the story of Manitoba from the Arctic coast to the prairie grasslands. The interrelationship of people and their environment comes to life in the interpretive displays of artifacts, specimens and dramatic walk-through settings.

Become an astronomical explorer and embark on a voyage of discovery in the full-dome **Planetarium Theatre**, featuring cutting edge Digistar® technology. Visitors go on a trip through the starry galaxy, including pre-produced shows or customized *Live with the Stars* presentations.

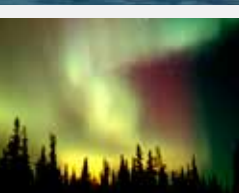
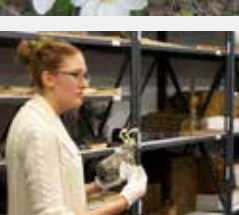

PROGRAM OPTIONS (prices are per person)

- **Welcome Receptions**, that step out of the box! Enjoy a private tour, cocktails and dinner in the award-winning Museum Galleries. **Program length – 3 hours** (starting at \$135)
- **Northern Exposure**, lets you discover the north as you delve into the Inuit culture, experience the aurora and go behind the scenes. **Program length – Full day, with lunch options available** (starting at \$52)
- **Inuit People of the North** provides you with an understanding of the traditional lifestyles of the Inuit people, and the limited resources, integral to their survival. Includes interactive artifact study. **Program length – 2 hours** (starting at \$22)
- **Summer Arctic Alive** features the biology of the northern flora and fauna of Manitoba through a guided museum tour, followed by a presentation from our botanist on the northern plant ecology. **Program length – 2 hours** (starting at \$25)
- **Behind the Scenes of the Great Canadian Fur Trade** transports you to mid-19th century Manitoba and experience the drama and excitement of the fur trade. Go behind the scenes and view rarely-seen objects in the Hudson's Bay Company Museum Collection's storage vaults. **Program length – 3 hours** (starting at \$25)
- **Company of Adventurers** takes you on a tour the Hudson's Bay Company Gallery, and board the Nonsuch. Gain an appreciation of the people involved in the fur trade and the impact it had on both Indigenous and European traders. Includes interactive artifact study. **Program length – 2 hours** (starting at \$17)
- **Water & Ice – Sustainable Resources** examines the ecosystems that exist and thrive in the Arctic and Antarctic. Learn how this is connected to your own. See how what you do can impact the health of our lakes, while considering economic and social impact. **Program length – 2 hours** (starting at \$17)
- **Arctic Skies** – Begin your adventure with the Planetarium presentation *Experiencing the Aurora*, followed by an interactive tour of the Museum Galleries focusing on the Inuit Peoples and the fur trade. **Program length – 2 hours** (starting at \$25)
