

Spooktacular Family Night at the Museum FAQ

Q: When is Spooktacular Family Night at the Museum?

Friday, October 25 from 6pm -9pm. Visitors must purchase tickets prior to the event at the Box Office, over the phone or online to attend. No tickets will be sold at the door.

Q: What is the cost to attend Spooktacular Family Night at the Museum?

Member Child \$5 / General Public Child \$10
Member Adult FREE/ General Public Adult \$5

Please note: GST is added to the cost of the event admission. Adults are required to supervise their children at all times during this event. Adults are welcome to participate in all of the activities but will not be receiving candy.

Q: What should we expect for Spooktacular Family Night at the Museum?

Spooktacular Family Night is a fun Halloween event at the Manitoba Museum where children, and some adults, dress up in family-friendly costumes to trick or treat at stations set up throughout the Museum.

Children will receive a Spooktacular Family Night passport that will allow them to explore the Museum and trick or treat while receiving a stamp for every station they stop at. Collect all 10 stamps from our 10 Halloween stations and enter to win a FREE family membership!

The Museum Galleries will be decorated for Halloween providing fun backdrops for photo opportunities with your family. The Science Gallery will also be open including activities in the Explore Science Zone with spine-chilling live science demos. The Planetarium will be showing live eerie Planetarium shows throughout the night. In Alloway Hall, take part in fun ghoulish family crafts and visit Petland from 6pm-8pm to meet a variety of exciting critters.

Q: Will food be served at this event?

There will be pizza available for purchase for \$2 per slice and \$1 drinks in Festival Hall. Make sure you pre-order your pizza and drinks in advance to ensure you will not be disappointed. Pizza and drinks can be purchased at the Box Office, over the phone or online when purchasing your event tickets. Limited quantities while supplies last.

Q: Do I have to bring member cards if I purchased member priced tickets? I think I might have lost them.

Yes, as we will be checking membership cards at the door for those who have purchased member priced tickets. If you think you might have lost or misplaced your membership cards

there is a \$3 per card replacement fee that you can pay either at the box office or over the phone before the event.

[Q: I am member, can we bring my child's best friend/non-member?](#)

Yes, member will have the chance to purchase early bird General Public Child and Adult admission tickets to the event. Membership cards will be checked at the door for all purchased member priced tickets.
